YOU GAVE KAREN HOPE AND COMFORT

Karen's retirement was secure, or so she thought. Married with two daughters, a Navy pension and Social Security, she was set for life. Her free time was spent meaningfully, volunteering at the Storehouse Food Pantry at 5 Point Church.

The divorce came out of nowhere and suddenly Karen found herself in dire straits. She dealt with a really bad case of COVID that left her bedridden. To say she was depressed was an understatement...the will to live was questionable. With \$10 in her checking account, a mountain of bills and her financial security crushed, Karen confided in 5 Point Church's Lesa Howard.

Lesa knew just who could help Karen... YOU, through Pathways.

Joe Walker was assigned to coach Karen who understood the reality of her financial situation. She started making really hard life choices. Knowing she couldn't afford her truck and auto insurance, she sold it and now relies on her daughter and Uber for transportation.

Karen made the ultimate and heartbreaking sacrifice of fostering her beloved dog. She knew there was no way she could afford the expense of a pet.

Together with Joe, Karen developed a plan and worked it hard. Joe says she is the most compliant person he has ever coached. They took advantage of programs like Power Pay, a free debt reduction program at Utah State University Extension.

Because of generous donors like you, Pathways was able to help Karen reduce tax debt which freed up additional funds that she could use to pay off credit card debt. She is also maximizing the matched savings program that donors like you fund.

Karen now sees a light at the end of tunnel. She has you to thank. There really are no words to express her gratitude for you. You saved her life.

YOU GAVE BRENDA THE HAND UP SHE NEEDED

Brenda found love after the end of her 25-year marriage. She lived in New Jersey and bought a condominium in 2008 when housing prices were inflated. Years later, through Facebook, she reconnected with an old childhood friend, Jim. They have been together for ten years!

Jim has relatives in South Carolina and bought land from his cousin who lives in Pickens. Jim and Brenda discussed building on the land. Brenda loves the mountains and country life.

Brenda sold her condo and accessed her retirement annuity at age 59 ½ years. In hindsight, it wasn't the best decision but Brenda was ready to take the risk. The rest of her money went to pay off debt but left her with no savings. Jim received Social Security but he also had debts.

Brenda and Jim had dreams of traveling the country so she bought an RV and leased a truck to tow it. They lived in the RV on their land for 6 months until Jim suffered a series of health issues that made that dream unattainable. Now Brenda is his full-time caregiver. This has taken a huge toll on her...physically, mentally and financially.

She picked up one of our Pathways brochures at the Easley Library. It said, "Are you tired living paycheck to paycheck?" Brenda held on to the brochure but didn't call because she was prideful and embarrassed and had never needed help before.

Finally, she put her pride aside and called United Way of Pickens County. She connected with Pathways Success Coach Joe Walker, who realized that Brenda was VERY depressed and referred her to our mental health counselor. We are so grateful to our donors like you who provide the funding to have mental health services available for our participants. Because of you, we are able to treat the "whole" person.

Brenda and Joe are slowly working her plan and she is extremely compliant and very detail oriented. Because we do not advertise incentivizing met goals, Brenda was shocked when Joe helped her pay off one loan.
