Allocation of Tax Amounts for Individuals in Certain States 3



- Non-Resident: You are a Nonresident if you were not a resident of South Carolina but earned South Carolina income. If you are filing a joint tax return and one spouse is a resident of SC but the other spouse is not, select to file the SC Nonresident return and adjust the taxable income on Schedule NR. (Part year residents may choose to file a resident or nonresident return)

Getting Ready to File

-It may ask you to add your ID. This section is optional.

-It will ask you if you filed taxes last year. If you did, it'll ask you to provide your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) from last year. This will be on your 1040 NR from last year.

Tip: If you do not have this info. You can create an account at https://www.id.me/ to find past tax records.

Now, create a Self-Select PIN for this year Create a 5-digit PIN for this year's tax return. We'll import it for you when you file next year. *You may be asked for this PIN in the future so the IRS can confirm your identity. We recommend making note of your PIN and keeping track of it. Taxpayer's 5-digit PIN * CANCEL

-It will then ask you to create a 5-digit PIN number. It can be any 5 numbers you'd like.

E-File Your Tax Return

Click E-File and you are finished!!

It will be rejected or accepted within a few minutes.

If you cannot, contact a VITA representative near you for assistance by calling 2-1-1.

If you still cannot fix it, you'll need to mail in your return. See the next page for assistance in mailing in a return.
